

## 2022 NBLL AA Division Rules


(Revised March 2022)

1. Games are restricted to 2 hours. A new inning may not begin after one hour and 30 minutes. If a new inning is begun, both teams will have the opportunity to complete their at bat.
2. No player shall sit out more than two innings in any regulation game, except for cases of illness, injury, or disciplinary action by the manager or umpire. An inning is defined as 3 outs by any team or the conclusion of the game by the time limit being reached.
3. During each game, each player should have playing time in both the infield and the outfield. No player should play the same position for more than three innings per game.
4. Every player on the roster bats, even if not currently playing defense. Substitutions do not affect the batting order.
5. A team may place up to 10 players on defense. When using 10 fielders, four must be located in the outfield (on the grass or a reasonable distance behind infielders on larger fields).
6. An on-deck batter is not permitted at any time.
7. Pitching Restrictions (from 2021 Little League Rule Book):
  - a. Any player on a roster may pitch; there is no limit to the number of pitchers per game.
  - b. Any player who has played 4 or more innings of catcher may not pitch that day.
  - c. Once a pitcher is removed, he may not pitch again in the same game.
  - d. A pitcher who delivers 41 or more pitches in a game cannot play the catcher position for the remainder of that day.
  - e. If a pitcher hits two batters in one inning or three batters in a single game, he/she may no longer pitch in that game.
  - f. Required days of rest

1. >= 66 pitches		4 calendar days rest
2. 51-65 pitches		3 calendar days rest
3. 36-50 pitches		2 calendar days rest
4. 21-35 pitches		1 calendar day of rest
5. 1-20 pitches		0 calendar days
  - g. Maximum pitches per game:

1. Age 11-12		85 pitches
2. Age 9-10		75 pitches
3. Age 7-8		50 pitches
  - h. If the pitcher reaches the limit while facing a batter, the pitcher may continue to pitch until a) that batter reaches base, b) that batter is put out, or c) the third out is made to complete the half inning.

14. There is no 10-run (mercy rule) in AA. Play continues until the time limit is reached, 6 innings have been played, or the game is suspended due to weather/darkness. Games may end in a tie.
15. Win / Loss records are not kept in AA.
